• If you're looking to create a digital image that looks like a traditional photograph, you'll need to understand the characteristics of photographic film. You'll also have to understand a little bit about how the light travels to different areas of the camera and how the camera captures it. To create an image that looks like the photograph, create a new document. Set the document size at the maximum. Use a deep black background and place the subject in the center of the document. Photoshop has an auto white-balance feature. For more on auto white-balance, see the section "Creating a white-balanced image." • Create a new layer for each of your subjects. For example, if your image includes a close-up portrait, create a layer for the subject. Each layer can contain one of your subject's facial features, a specific facial expression, or a body part. For example, you can put the subject's lips on a separate layer from the subject's eyes. The image software keeps each layer separate so that you can manipulate the different elements of your image, as you see in the following section.

The only other alternative is GIMP (GNU Image Manipulation Program). This free and open-source graphics editor is used by amateur and professionals alike. It runs as a standalone application or as a plugin for GNOME/GTK+ and Windows. It supports many image and vector file formats. Which one should you choose? Unlike other graphic editing software, Photoshop has gained a lot of reputation. It is widely used by professionals and hobbyists alike. Pixlr, one of the better and popular free graphic editors is based on Photoshop. It has a very simple and user-friendly interface. Adobe Photoshop/Illustrator is a high-end graphic editing software package, and requires a license for a few thousand dollars. There are limited educational and free versions available. GIMP is an open-source alternative, and most of the professional graphics editors are GIMP plugins. The latter is an integrated graphics editor that is written in C language and is able to edit both image and vector. Where and how do you use Photoshop Elements? Once you install Photoshop Elements, it is always available on your taskbar. The software's interface looks similar to a screen that was used in Windows Vista to manage settings on your PC. However, there are several differences between Photoshop Elements and the older version of Photoshop. The first difference is in the set of features that a user can access. If you are familiar with Photoshop, you might already know some of these tools. But if you are a beginner, you might not know all these features as well. For example, Photoshop Elements has tools for cropping, rotating and mirroring images and for editing the content of images. The professional version of Photoshop offers many more features.
