

Human rights groups and country-specific NGOs have condemned an incident in which a group of civilians - armed with iron bars - were stopped on their way from the village of Salim to Bucharest, as they tried to take part in the anniversary of the 1989 anti-government protests. Dossita, a Romanian NGO advocating for human rights in relation to Roma and Sinti, the country's largest minority, confirmed that they received information of more than 200 men attempting to take part in the commemorations on January 21. According to the NGO's press release, the men gathered at the village of Salim, near the North-East city of Iaşi, where they formed a human chain, forming a route to the capital city Bucharest. "We regret that on 21st January, the 200 people who took part in this patriotic action were prevented from their march and subjected to attacks from the police," the press release reads. In the weeks preceding the event, villagers were contacted by local officials who told them that they were not allowed to take part in any such manifestations during the celebrations. Images of the incident were posted on social media. One of the villagers, Serafim Morosteanu, told local media that he was beaten while in custody by Romanian police. In 2015, Bucharest's European Capital of Culture, Iasi was allowed to commemorate the first anniversary of the anti-government demonstrations, despite vocal opposition from Romanian authorities. Around 85,000 people took part in the event, with thousands risking physical injury, imprisonment and detention to take part in protests against unfair taxes, poor living standards and corruption. In the lead-up to the first anniversary, similar protests were held in other cities across the country. In December 2017, the organisers of the event were detained by police and a warrant was issued for the arrest of President Klaus Iohannis. Following the incident in Salim, the Iasi police department issued a statement claiming that they would take strict measures to prevent the demonstration from taking place. The statement did not mention the use of violence against protesters. The Council of Europe has been "appalled" by the use of violence by the Romanian police against protesters in the country. Three Iaşi residents who were arrested and beaten on January 21 were later released for lack of

evidence. Another nine of the protesters were
